Here you trace the fascinating lives of the people who have shaped the story of Poole. Evocative displays include an interactive 1950s kitchen.



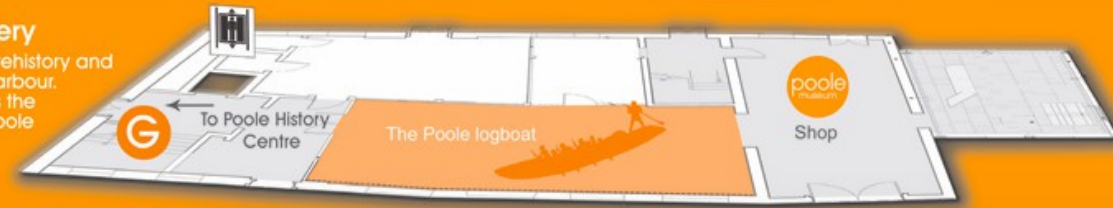
First floor gallery

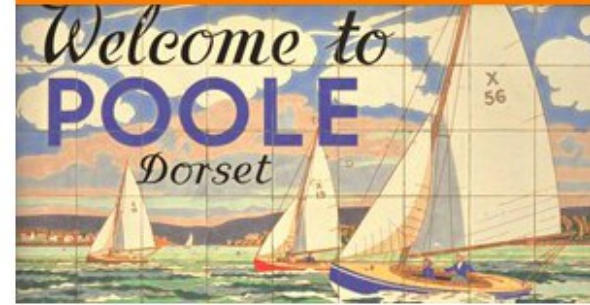
